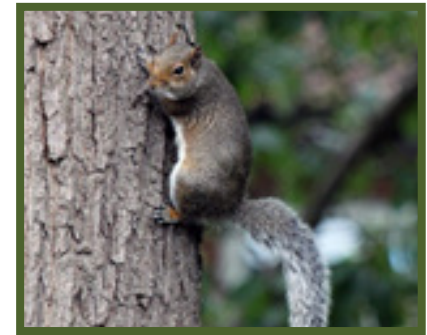

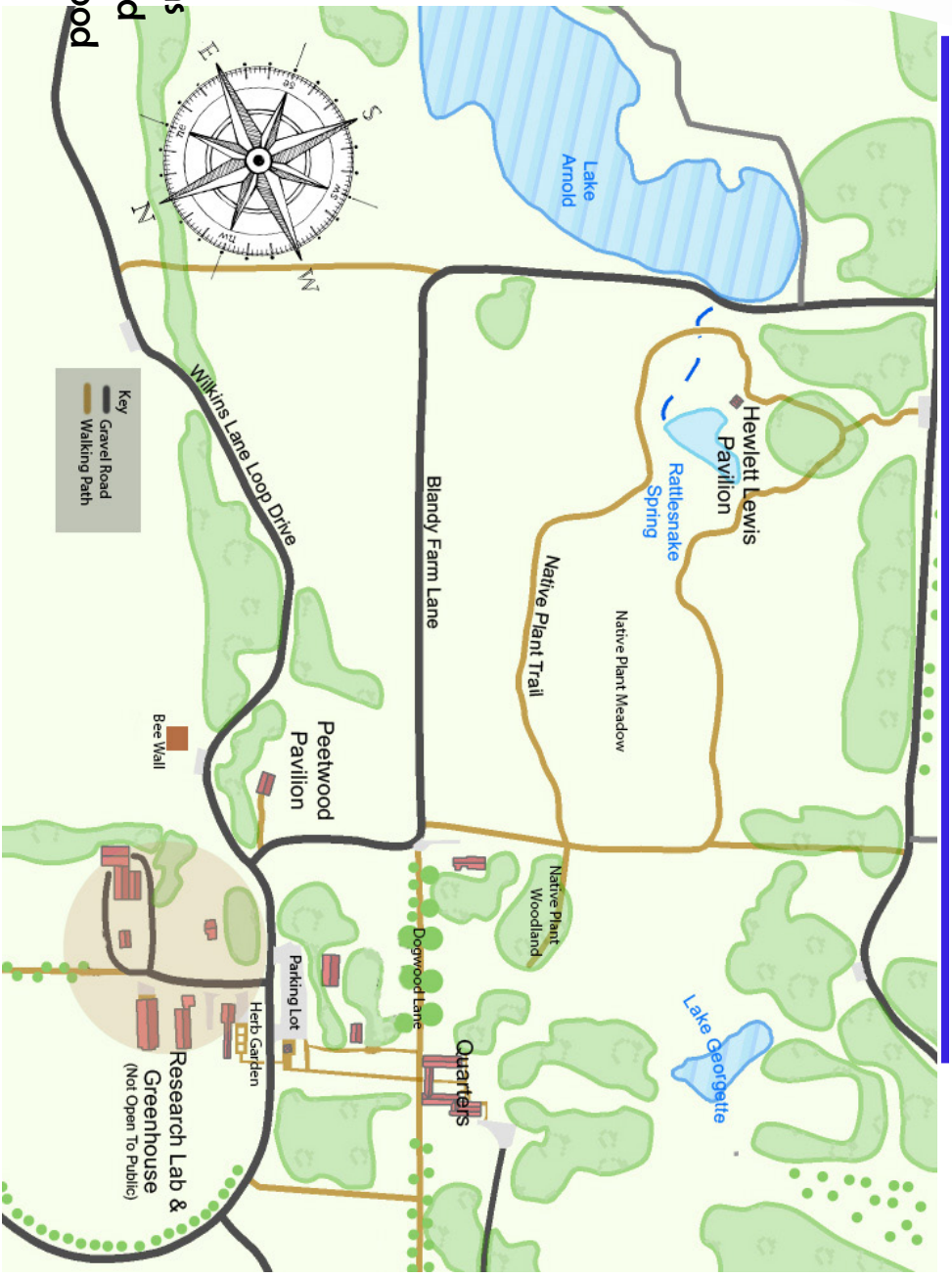
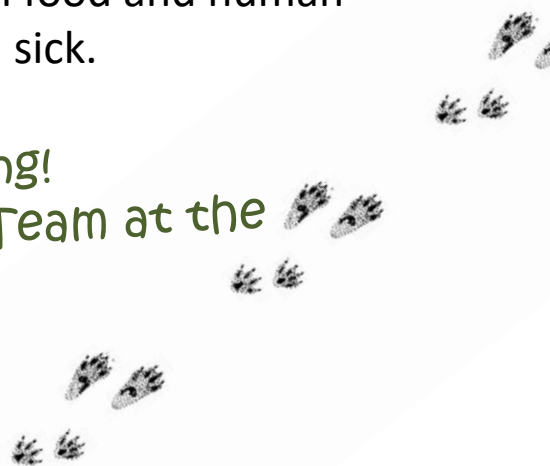




## SQUIRREL!!
