A learner-centered experience that focuses on investigations into local environmental issues that lead to informed civic engagement

- 1. Issue definition
- 2. Outdoor field investigations
- 3. Action projects/Civic engagement
- 4. Issue synthesis, conclusions, & communications

#### Virginia Curriculum Framework

- SEPs: Indicated by a leaf icon
- Details for each content standard:
  - Central Idea
  - Vertical Alignment: what students have been taught in earlier grades & will be taught in later grades (grade level connections)
  - Enduring Understandings: key concepts & big ideas that students learn
  - Essential Knowledge & Practices: what students should know & be able to do related to the standard
